

NIH Supervisory Refresher Training Resources

September 15, 2011

All newly appointed or first-time NIH supervisors selected in December 2009 and thereafter must receive formal training during their first year of appointment to a supervisory role. Details on mandatory new supervisory training can be found at http://trainingcenter.nih.gov/mandatory_supervisory_training.html.

Once the initial training requirement has been met, supervisory refresher training is then required every three years to satisfy OPM regulation: 5 CFR Parts 410 and 412. Supervisors in supervisory roles prior to December 2009 must also receive refresher training every three years. Thus, this group of supervisors will report their completion of supervisory refresher training by December 2012.

In addition, HHS is in the process of implementing a policy requiring that the refresher training be sixteen hours required every two years. Additional details on the status of this policy can be found at the above link.

Every three years, supervisors must take refresher training addressing the required OPM topic areas and any desired NIH leadership and management competencies. The OPM topic areas can be found in the NIH Guidance document at the above link.
